Clinical History: The patient is an otherwise healthy 36-year-old woman with a ten-year history of neck pain. Recent exacerbation of the neck pain with visual changes, facial and extremity weakness was followed by symptoms of an acute increase in intracranial pressure and mild Broca's aphasia. Imaging showed a 5-cm, partially calcified mass near the sphenoid in the temporal lobe.
