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## Case 2008-10

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Diagnosis: Plexiform perineurioma

**Comment:** Key immunohistochemical studies included positive reactions for EMA, Glut-1 and claudin-1, which are positive in perineurial cells, and also collagen VI; S-100 was negative, as were neurofilament protein, SMA and keratin. Only a few examples of this lesion have been described, all occurring in females.
