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Clinical History: A 45-year-old woman presented to an outside institution with non-specific neurological symptoms. Imaging demonstrated a 4.6 cm mass within the right frontal horn of her lateral ventricle. The mass extended into her right frontal lobe and exhibited a significant amount of surrounding vasogenic edema. We received the case as a consult.
