39-year-old woman

Diagnosis of Lupus Erythematosus at age 33.
Asymptomatic on high doses ateroids

1 month before death discontinued medication 10 days before death - abdominal pain, numbness in extremities, became confused, discriented and final comatose, Died within 24 hours after admission.

P. M. Diagnosis: Inactive lupus erythematosus

Brain: Gross - Moderate convolutional atrophy and meningeal fibrosis

Microscopic - Focal lesions were largely limited to cerebral cortex

Stain: Feigen's modification Asocarmine
