██████████ 39-year-old woman

██████████ Diagnosis of Lupus Erythematosus at age 33.
Asymptomatic on high doses steroids

1 month before death discontinued medication
10 days before death - abdominal pain, numbness in extremities, became
confused, disoriented and final comatose. Died within 24 hours after
admission.

P. M. Diagnosis: Inactive lupus erythematosus

Brain: Gross - Moderate convolutional atrophy and meningeal fibrosis

Microscopic - Focal lesions were largely limited to
cerebral cortex

Stain: Feigen's modification Azocarmine
