## CASE 10

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## Clinical Abstract:

A 43-year-old woman was referred to the neurosurgery service with a one year history of weakness of her right arm and shoulder. Six months earlier she experienced focal seizure activity beginning in the right hand and progressing to involve the shoulder. She was left handed and did not notice any speech disturbance associated with her seizures. A CT scan of the head demonstrated a large enhancing frontoparietal mass on the left side. A craniotomy was performed.

Point for discussion: Diagnosis.
